Roger Connors Of Cablevision

MR. CONNOR EXPLAINED

ABOUT DIGITAL (NEW FLAT TELEVISONS THAT USUALLY HANG ON THE WALL) AND ANALOG TELEVISION SETS (OLDER, THICKER SETS THAT SIT ON A FLAT SURFACE) AND THE ONGOING DEVELOPMENT OF NEW TECHNOLOGY TO DIGITAL SETS. NOW, IF A CABLEVISON CUSTOMER HAS AN ANALOG SET, THEY ARE UNABLE TO RECEIVE THREE PUBLIC ACCESS CHANNELS, 18, 20 AND 22, WITHOUT A BOX. THE BOXES ARE GIVEN FREE OF CHARGE TO CABLEVISION CUSTOMERS AT THE WAPPINGERS STORE UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008 AND THE CUSTOMER MAY KEEP THE BOX FOR THE LIFE OF THEIR ANALOG TV SET. AS THE TECHNOLOGY COMPLETES ITS TRANSITION FROM ANAGLOG TO DIGITAL, EVENTUALLY TV MANUFACTURERS WILL ENCLOSE A BOX INSIDE THE TELEVISION SET SO THAT CUSTOMERS CAN GET THE PUBLIC ACESS CHANNELS.

SUPERVISOR MYERS ANNOUNCED THAT THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NOTIFIED THE TOWN THAT THEY WANT TO POST A SPEED LIMIT OF 30 MILES PER HOUR ON RAYMOND AVENUE FROM HOOKER AVENUE TO THE WEST BOUND ARTERIAL
