WOJTOWICZ) Davis and David Hagstrom. The Chapter 159  
Violations is a chapter that deals with “Property Maintenance”. A section of this  
chapter deals with penalties of offenses and charges if the Town has to remove  
materials in violation of the Code. Since Marc Pfeifer, Superintendent of  
Highways, is doing most of the clean up work, Mr. Wojtowicz has established an  
expense account for him. Mr. Wojtowicz keeps an individual expense tally on  
each of the properties being worked on. He has sent out certified letters to the  
owners and bills for the cleaning process. If the bills are not paid by the owner, a  
lien will be placed on their tax bill.
