**TOWN OF POUGHKEEPSIE
LOCAL LAW NO. ____ OF THE YEAR 2016**

A local law providing for a four year term for the elective office of Town Clerk.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Poughkeepsie pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 10 as follows:

Section 1.

The term of the elective office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Poughkeepsie shall be four years. Such four year term shall commence on January 1, 2018, to be followed by four year terms thereafter.

Section 2.

This local law shall supercede in its application to the Town of Poughkeepsie Section 24 of the Town Law with respect to the term of office of the elective Town Clerk.

Section 3.

This local law shall be submitted for approval by the electors of the Town of Poughkeepsie at the next general Town election to be held on November 8, 2016 in the Town of Poughkeepsie. A proposition in the following form shall be included on the ballot of such general Town election and the increased term of office as set forth therein shall not take effect unless the proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting thereon:

“Shall the term of office of the Town Clerk of the
Poughkeepsie be increased from two years to four years with
the term of office commencing January 1, 2018, as set forth
in Local Law No. ____ of 2016.”

Section 4. Separability

If any part or provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Poughkeepsie hereby declares that it would have passed this local law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws, and parts thereof inconsistent with this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date

This law shall become effective immediately upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
