RESOLUTION 10:20- #SC 1 OF 2021

WHEREAS, in response to the Covid epidemic, and in an effort to support the local economy, the Town Board of Town of Poughkeepsie on June 17, 2020, after adopting a SEQR Negative Declaration, by Resolution 6:17 - #2A of 2020 adopted Local Law #6 of 2020 (Town Code 210-109.1) which allowed the temporary use of public and private premises for outdoor dining and sidewalk seating through April 30, 2021, the provisions of which local law were extended by Resolution 4:21- #SC 1 of 2021, pursuant to Dutchess County Emergency Order #12 of June 8, 2020, through October 31, 2021, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 6:17 - #2B of 2020 this Town Board also authorized the temporary closure of portions of Collegeview Avenue, authorized food establishments to operate outdoor dining facilities thereon as determined by the Development Director, and authorized the creation of common public dining areas on Collegeview Avenue and elsewhere on Town properties as determined by the Supervisor or his designee, which authorizations remain in full force and effect, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to extend the effective date of local law #6 of 2020 regarding Outdoor Dining through October 31, 2022, subject to the operating establishments complying with State and County laws and regulations, and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law amending and extending Town Code §210-109.1G is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, with the deleted language ~~striken~~ and the added language underscored, and the Town Board waives a verbatim reading of it and directs that it be spread across the record as if it, in fact, had been read verbatim; and

WHEREAS, the Local Law proposed to be extended has previously been determined to have no potential to create a significant adverse environmental impact under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the proposed Local Law requires a public hearing,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. For the reasons aforesaid, and because the extension of this Local Law involves the continuation of routine Town administrative practices, without any major reordering of priorities, it is a Type II Action requiring no environmental review; and
2. The Town Board hereby sets a public hearing on the proposed Local Law for November 3, 2021, at 7:00 PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may come to be heard, at the Town Hall, One Overocker Road, Poughkeepsie, New York, at which time interested parties may participate in person or electronically by logging into Zoom, which accessing information is noted on the Town Board agenda; and
3. The Town Board refers this matter to the Dutchess County Department of Planning and Economic Development for its recommendation pursuant to GML §239-m; and
4. The Town Board refers this matter to the Town of Poughkeepsie Planning Board for an advisory report pursuant to Town Code Section 210-154; and
5. The Town Board respectfully requests that the Town Planning Board and the County Department of Planning and Economic Development attempt to respond on or before the scheduled Public Hearing date; and
6. The Town Board directs the Town Clerk to notify the Town Clerks of each of the surrounding municipalities of the public hearing pursuant to GML 239-nn.
