Dear Sir or Madam:


The Town of Poughkeepsie is seeking proposals from qualified traffic engineers to potentially assist in two areas. First: Advising re the appropriate replacement traffic control system to be installed at the intersection of North Grand Avenue & Marple Road, and Second: The provision of traffic advice and analysis on an hourly or task basis as needed.

The four way traffic light at Marple Road & North Grand Avenue was recently removed after suffering substantial damage as the result of a motor vehicle collision. Temporary four way stop signs have been posted. The Town seeks a price quotation to advise whether to replace the light, make the four way stop signs permanent, or install another control system. It also seeks an estimate of the cost of the recommended system.

The Town also from time to time seeks traffic engineering advice, analysis, studies and consultations on an hourly and per task basis.
