NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Fairview Fire District will convene via telephone conference call to conduct a Special Board meeting at 5:00 PM on April 15, 2020 for Executive Session only, the for the purpose of the medical and/or employment history of a particular person(s) or corporation, or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal or removal of a particular person or corporation.

The Meeting will be held in accordance with the New York State Public Officers Law, as modified or suspended by Executive Order 202.1, issued on March 12, 2020 by New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo. EO 202.1 suspended Article 7 of the Public Officers Law, to the extent necessary to allow any public body to meet and conduct its public business without allowing the public to attend such meeting in person, and further authorized such meeting to be held remotely by telephone conference call or similar service, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed.

In view of the on-going public health emergency and the restrictions on in-person meetings ordered by Executive Orders 202.4, issued on March 1*, 2020; and 202.10, issued on March 23, 2020, the Board anticipates the meeting will be conducted by telephone conference call. While there will not be a physical meeting location, for the purpose of compliance with applicable law as to the location of meetings, the meeting shall be deemed to be convened at the Fairview Firehouse, 258 Violet Avenue, Poughkeepsie.

It is anticipated that the Commissioners and staff will attend and participate in the Meeting by telephone conference call.

The written record of the meeting will be available for public review within ten days of the meeting date.

The Firehouse will not be open to the public for meetings of the Board of Fire Commissioners during the time that the Executive Orders remain in effect. THERE WILL BE NO IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETING.
